Introduction to AdoptionPAL

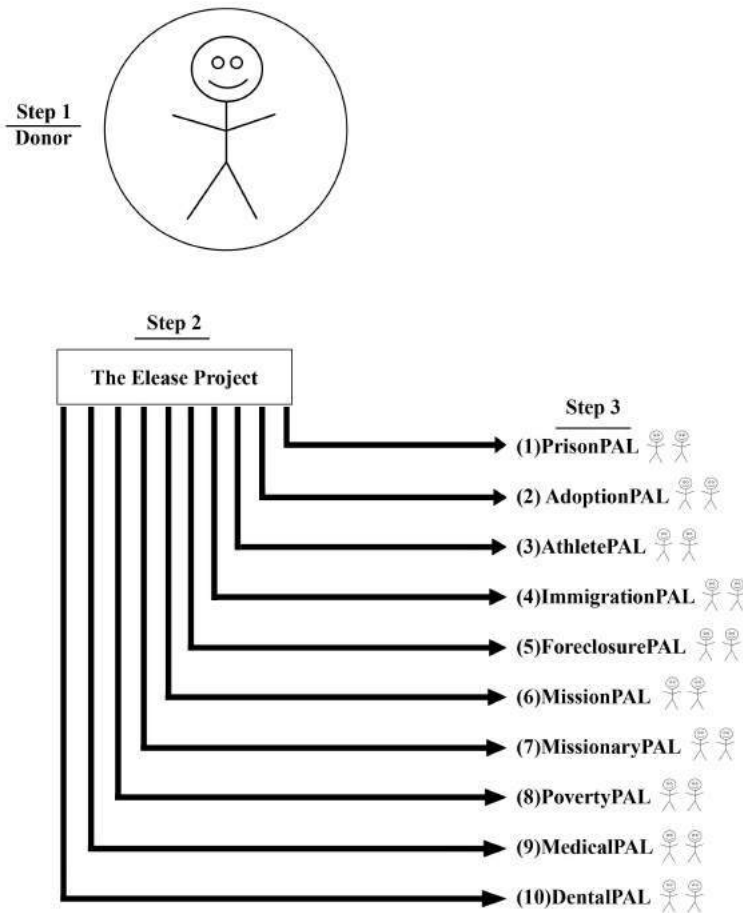
AdoptionPAL is one of the 10 important pieces of The Elease Project. AdoptionPAL is comprised of two parts. (Part one) This ministry rescues animals that are mistreated. The animals are treated medically and removed from harmful owners. Also we rescue abandoned animals that have no chance to make it without our help. We get possession of these animals and get them immediate shelter, food, nutrition, and medical care. These animals are given care all the way until they recover to normal health. Our website will list these animals and their pictures and their progress. A rescue facility that we own gets these animals the love and care they need to mentally, physically, and emotionally get ready for adoption. Our website allows for families with children and elderly people to get first choice and then adults without children choose next. Our large animals such as horses are open to all people from day one. Our goal is to get the medical technology device (Bemer) onto all of these animals for quick healing. (Part Two) This process is a vetting process and background check of the individuals and families who are applying to adopt one of our rescued animals. This background check is very similar to the process that a family goes through to adopt a child. Our goal is to take strays, abandoned animals, lost animals, and mistreated animals and give them a chance to make it, to heal, to survive, and to live a great life with loved ones that are willing to adopt them and love them with care till the end of the animals life.

The ten PALS (section) of The Elease Project are unique in structure. When Keith Hatchett researched the wealthy people of the United States and how they fund charities, he found an unusual problem in that the donor had to say no to many charities each year and yes to only one or two. This is a problem and an uncomfortable problem as most people hate to say no to charities.

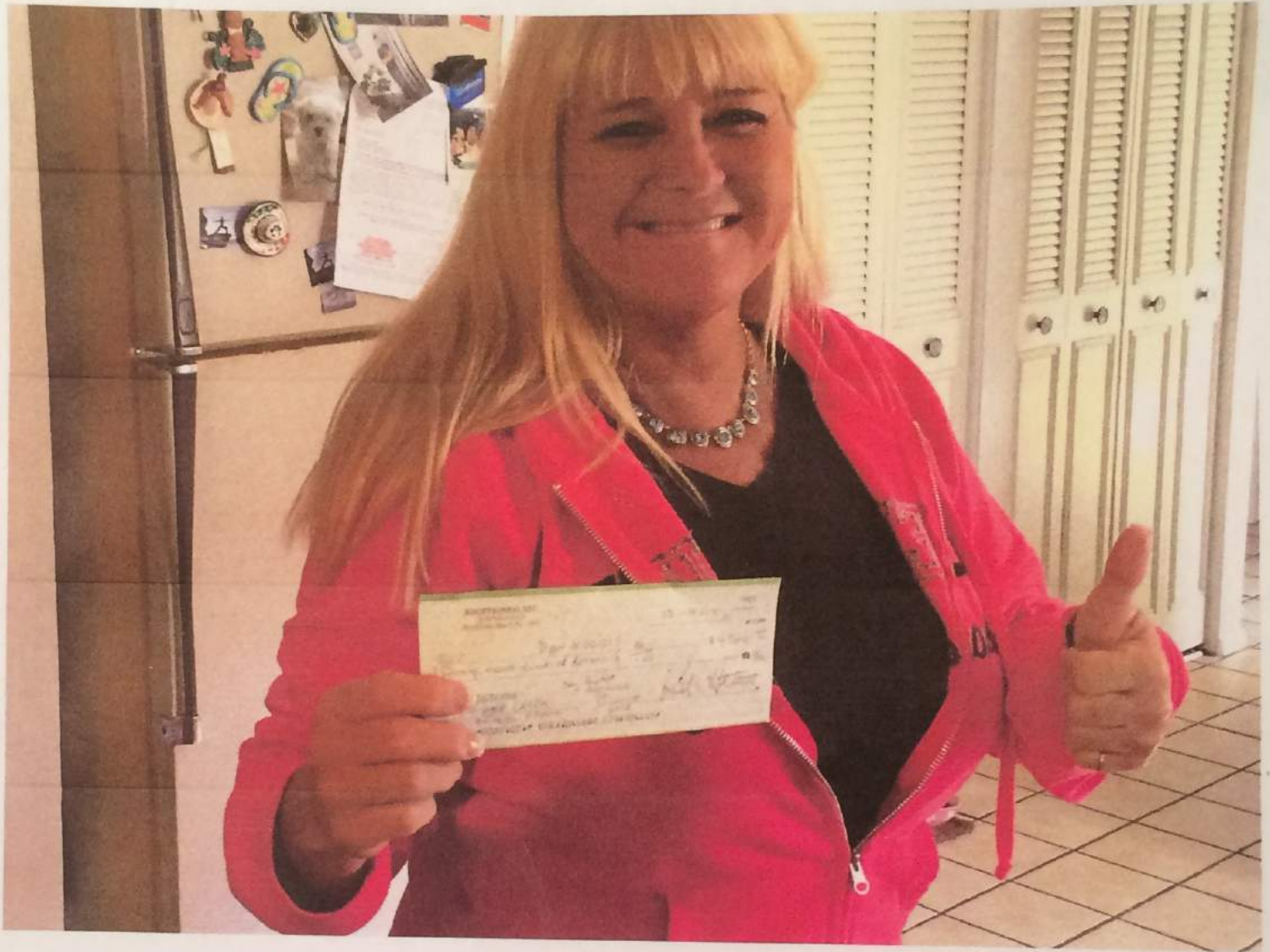
