## Introduction to MedicalPAL

### **Pediatric Innovation Education Center**

A Model of a Family Support Center for Children with Chronic Conditions

Families who take care of children with chronic conditions face immense challenges. We are building a Community of Families, Health Care Practitioners, Educators and Organizations to support Children's Wellness.

The first model will be in Northern Virginia to provide an Integrative Model of Care focused on Innovation in Pediatric Care. A model of education, training, and support for the kids, their families, and their health care team working collaboratively in one space. We plan on making this model available to others to replicate in other locations around the country.

We work together with the Hospitals, Practitioners, Non-Profits and Parent Groups to provide these families a Community that shifts the focus to HOPE, rather than focusing on the increasing crisis we face in pediatric care.

### **EDUCATION CENTER**

Our Education Center Invites Leaders in Pediatric Care to share Innovative practices with parents and other practitioners through Seminars, Workshops and Trainings.

### **BUSINESS INCUBATOR**

Office Space and support will provide Parents the opportunity to start and manage their own business with a peace of mind that their child is well taken care of in the same location.

### **RESOURCE CENTER**

The resource center provides assistance and support by streamlining services and communications to programs and services available to families of chronically ill children.

### **KIDZ ACADEMY**

Learn / Play / Thrive

Kids learn best in an engaging and stimulating environment of social interaction through play and learning. Caring educators with specialized training attend to the child with extra care that inspires them to thrive. The Academy is a Space for Recreation, Fitness, Education, Art, Music and innovative methods to support the child's development and well being.

## **WELLNESS CENTER**

For Mom & Dad / Child / Practitioners

Wellness Services to support everyone facing the stressful conditions of caring for the child so that the best care can be given.

## **NUTRITION CENTER**

Parents and Practitioners can learn about the importance of nutrition to support their child's well being.

### **The Team**

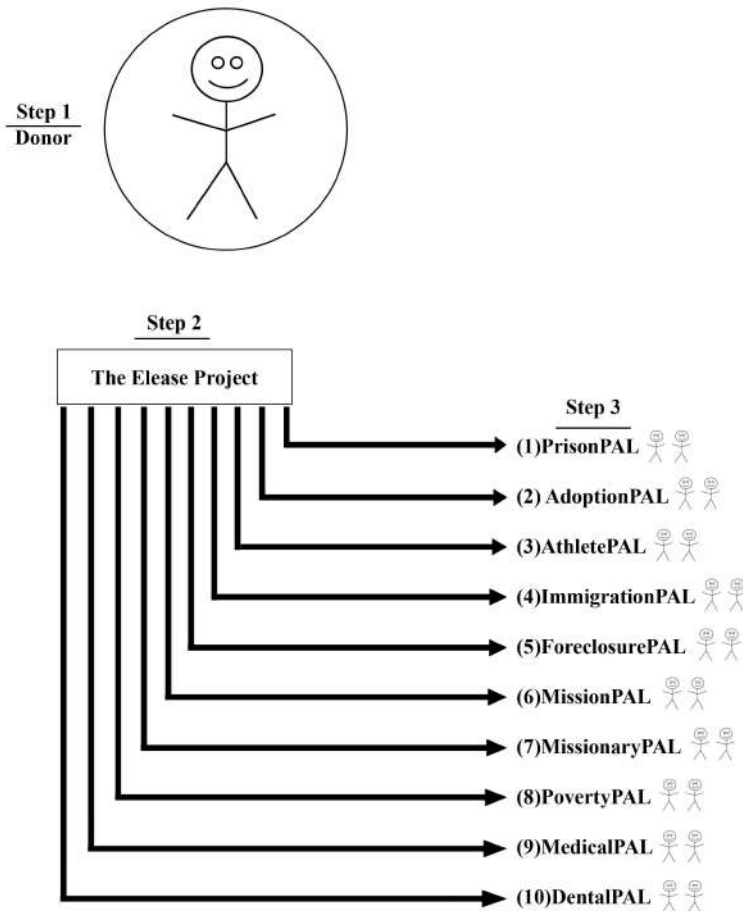

Business Center (Office equipment and furniture)	\$15,000
Resource Center (Office equipment and furniture)	\$8,000
Wellness Center (Therapy equipment and furniture)	\$30,000
Education Center (AV equipment and furniture)	\$5,000
Kidz Academy (Recreation/Fitness/Therapy equipment and furniture)	\$12,000
Nutrition Center (upgrade of existing kitchen, appliances)	\$25,000
